#### **GETTING STARTED**

- 1. Can you think of a situation in which you thought you were special (exclusive/different), only to disappoint? What happened?
- 2. What was the main challenge or idea that stood out to you from the message on Sunday?

### REFLECTING ON THE MESSAGE

Key Scripture: Mark 9:38-41; Philippians 1:15-18; Matthew 12:30-32; Acts 19:13-16

(Read Mark 9:38-41)

- 1. What do you notice about this text? What stands out?
- 2. John's words speak to seeking to build an empire, instead of God's Kingdom. What is the difference between building God's Kingdom and building worldly empires?
  - a. Where do you see worldly empires being build amongst Christians?
  - b. What is the fruit of these empires?
- 3. What does the fruit of building God's Kingdom look like?
- 4. How does choosing to look at fruit change our perspective on those around us?

## RESPONDING TO THE MESSAGE

- Is there an area in your life you are seeking to be special and building an empire instead of God's Kingdom?
  - a. What fruit can you see in that space?
- 2. What would it look like to reach out and celebrate God's Kingdom with them instead?
