### REFLECTING ON THE MESSAGE

**Key Scriptures: Mark 11:1-11; Zechariah 9:9**

*(Read Mark 11:1-11)*

1. If you were one of the two disciples that Jesus sent for a donkey, how would you react?
2. Jesus' disciples did what was asked because they knew enough of His faithfulness. What examples of Jesus' faithfulness can you think of from your life?

*(Read Zechariah 9:9)*

3. What was Jesus declaring to the crowd by choosing to ride in on a donkey like this?
4. What does Jesus' entry into Jerusalem knowing it would lead to suffering teach us about the way He trusted God?

### RESPONDING TO THE MESSAGE

1. What do you feel God is asking you to do?
2. Is there something causing you to be unsure about it? What is it?
3. What examples of Jesus' faithfulness that might give you the courage to step forward?
4. What would it look like to encourage others to trust God's faithfulness even when obedience feels hard?
