GETTING STARTED

1. Take the opportunity to discuss the things that Rob shared about Araluen Christian College and Christian Education.
 - a. Was there anything that challenged you, surprised you, or caught your attention? Why?

REFLECTING ON THE MESSAGE

Key Scripture: Genesis 13:5-18;

(Read Genesis 13:5-9)

1. What is your response to conflict in your scattered places?
 - a. How might this be an opportunity to serve others and grow more like Christ?

(Read Genesis 13:10-13)

2. What are some examples in our world where we can be caught just seeing the surface of how things appear?
3. As we live out our role as the scattered church, discerning where God wants us to be, how do we choose to look deeper?

(Read Genesis 13:14-17)

4. What would it look like for God to absolutely transform your scattered place without limits?
 - a. What do you need to pray with bolder faith for?

RESPONDING TO THE MESSAGE

1. What is God challenging you to take away from this discussion as we engage with the scattered church?
