GETTING STARTED

1. Do you feel you are naturally hardwired to being **settled** or **scattered** in your life? In what ways?
2. What was the main challenge or idea that stood out to you from the message on Sunday?

REFLECTING ON THE MESSAGE

Key Scripture: Genesis 11:1-9; Genesis 12:1-9; Acts 1:7-11

1. What was so shocking about God's call to Abram in Genesis 12:1?
2. In what ways have you experienced the truth that 'The Call of God resists our desire to settle'?
3. How does it shift our focus if we understand that this call is not transactional, but missional?
4. Abram constructed altars as he followed God's call; what can these altars look like as we scatter?
5. What are some altars you currently have that remind of God's faithfulness and goodness in your life?

RESPONDING TO THE MESSAGE

1. What resources/ opportunities do you have that need to be taken from the settled to the scattered?
2. What are some examples of altars that you could build in your world this week?
